ISTA TESTING LAB

Great Northern's in-house certified ISTA® technicians can test and certify packages and fully loaded pallets in our state-of-the-art ISTA 6 test lab to pre-determine if packages are optimally designed and if modifications are needed.

The ISTA 6 tests expose packages to anticipated conditions and hazards that could be encountered throughout the supply chain and distribution channels. The ISTA 6 test protocols include:

- Vibration Testing
- Incline Testing
- Material Handling
- Free-Fall Drop Testing
- Compression Testing
